The CityParks Junior Tournament Series offers a fun, affordable opportunity for juniors to compete in USTA Eastern-sanctioned tournaments during the summer.

FORMAT

The Series is composed of five tournaments from June through August with each borough hosting one event. Players are awarded points at each tournament for every round won. A cumulative point list for each age category is compiled over the summer.

THE TOP 16 PLAYERS in each age group that have accumulated the most points at the end of the summer will qualify for the New York City Junior Invitational Championships, held at the USTA National Tennis Center in September.

THE POINT LIST

The Point List will be computed throughout the summer in the following manner:

Per tournament for 32-draw*

Winner	100 pts
Finalist	75 pts
Semifinalists	50 pts
Quarterfinalists	36 pts
1rst round winners	12 pts
1rst round losers	5 pts

*Points are reduced one level for 16-draw tournaments, beginning with 75 points awarded to the winner. Default penalty: Fifty points will be subtracted from a player's point total for a default. Updated Series point lists will be posted at each tournament location. Players must play a minimum of TWO CityParks Junior Series tournaments to be eligible to qualify for the Championships.

ELIGIBILITY

The CityParks Junior Tournament Series is a USTA Level 2 Eastern Metro-Regional event, open only to residents of the five boroughs. Results from the Series can be applied toward an Eastern regional ranking for New York City. Each tournament is comprised of the following age categories:

Boys & Girls 12 and under Boys & Girls 14 and under Boys & Girls 16 and under

All players are required to have a valid USTA card. Players that do not have a USTA card can obtain one by calling the USTA at (800) 990-8782 or www.USTA.com.

ENTRY FEE
